Community Reader Commitment:

Community Readers who are chosen to participate will volunteer a minimum of three hours.

- 30-60 minute initial consultation with Youth Services Librarian to discuss the theme of story time. Review and agree to Community Reader Guidelines. Youth Services Librarian will follow up this meeting with a list of book suggestions that are available in the ORL collection for the Community Reader to choose from.
- 30-60 minute story time practice with Youth Services Librarian. View the space that will be used. Community Reader will have decided on their two books to read. Practice reading out loud at the library. Program run through.
- 1 hour Community Reader Story Time with public attendance. The Community Reader with the Youth Services Librarian will deliver a 30 minute story time followed by the Community Banner activity.
