Service Guidelines

- To use ORL Makerspace equipment you must have completed a virtual or in-person certification. Only virtual certification is available during Covid 19 – click [here](#) to start your certification.
- Makerspaces are currently open for booking by certified makers only.
- Makerspace equipment is available by appointment only, makers must book online or by calling your local Makerspace.
- Recording studios / practice spaces remain closed until further notice.
- Makers must bring their own materials for use with the Cricut and sewing machine, ORL will not be providing material for these machines at this time.

Safety Guidelines

- Please arrive on time and leave on time – staff require time between bookings to sanitize the stations.
- Do not come to the Makerspace if you are experiencing any symptoms.
- Sanitize your hands when you arrive at the makerspace before using any of the equipment.
- Please bring a mask to your Makerspace booking.
- Masks must be worn during the entire time you are using the Makerspace.
- Social distancing of 6 feet between Makerspace users and between users and staff must be maintained at all times.
- If you are using a digitization station that required ear buds or headphones please bring your own. We will not be lending headphones at this time.
